APW awards a \$1,000 scholarship each spring to an undergraduate student – male or female – studying at an Arkansas college or university who is planning a career in mass communications or journalism.

Arkansas Press Women is an association of professional communicators in journalism, public information, business, education and government. We support each other through professional development, recognition and competition, networking among ourselves and through related organizations, and celebrating our triumphs and disasters together.

The scholarship recipient will be honored at a spring luncheon. Attendance is encouraged but not required.

Application deadline: 11:59 p.m., April 9, 2021

Eligibility

- Applicant must be entering her/his junior or senior year in the 2021-22 academic year.
- Applicants must be attending an Arkansas college or university.
- APW scholarship recipients are eligible to reapply the next year.
- APW does not discriminate based on gender, sexual orientation, race, color, national origin, religion or disability.

Criteria

The scholarship committee will give preference to the following applicants:

- Are majoring in journalism or mass communications.
- Have an overall grade point average of 3.25 or better.
- Have published writing or broadcast samples.
- Have career goals in line with APW's mission and clearly express how the scholarship will help them achieve those goals.
